As the Youth President, you are an advocate for the voices of children and young people and you represent those voices both within the Methodist Church in Britain and outside of the church. This creates some really amazing opportunities, hearing the voices of children and young people to find out what they're passionate about, and then going to some really exciting meetings with lots of different people. In my year, I've had the joy of going to an international conference to represent children and young people, I've spoken with the Archbishop of Canterbury about their concerns, hosted 3Generate and visited youth events up and down the country – to name just a few cool things.
